BY-LAW NO. 2004-179

SANITARY SEWER RATES BY-LAW

WHEREAS the City is authorized to enact by-laws imposing fees or charges for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of it pursuant to section 391 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* (S.O. 2001, c.25);

AND WHEREAS by Resolution No. 2004-715 passed at its Regular Meeting held on Monday, October 18, 2004 Council authorized a by-law to confirm the current fees and charges in place for sanitary sewer rates;

AND WHEREAS Notice of the Public Meeting in the matter of current sanitary sewer rates was given as required by Ontario Regulation 244/02 made under the *Municipal Act, 2001* (S.O., 2001, c.25) by advertisement in the North Bay Nugget on the 30th day of October, 2004 and on the 6th day of November, 2004;

AND WHEREAS a Public Meeting under the *Municipal Act* in the matter of the current sanitary sewer rates was held on the 22nd day of November, 2004.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. A sanitary sewer rate is hereby imposed upon the owners or occupants of lands which are supplied with sewage service.
2. The sanitary sewer rate hereby imposed shall be a charge on the water bill charged or chargeable in respect of such lands and shall be computed as one hundred and six per centum (106%) of the annual water rates or charges charged or chargeable in respect of such land where such lands are used for other than commercial and industrial purposes and not less than one hundred and six per centum (106%) of the annual water rates or charges charged or chargeable in respect of such lands where such lands are used for commercial or industrial purposes.
3. By-law No. 13-71, as amended, is hereby repealed.
