

BY-LAW NO. 1019

BEING A BY-LAW to amend By-Law Number 779 providing for the regulating of Traffic in the Public Streets of the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable by the Municipal Council of the City of North Bay to amend By-Law Number 779 which is a By-Law to regulate the Traffic in the Public Streets of the City of North Bay.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

(1) That Section Twenty-Three (23) of By-Law Number 779 is hereby repealed and the following inserted:--

23 - Through Highways:- The following Streets are designated as Through-Highways and as required by Sub-Section Two (2) of Section Thirty-Five (35) of the Highway Traffic Act, all operators or drivers of every vehicle shall immediately, before entering or crossing any of these streets bring the vehicle to a full stop.

The provisions of this Section shall not come into effect until signs have been erected in accordance with the regulations of the Department of Public Highways.

Main Street and Klock Avenue (from Main Street to the City Limits) shall be designated as Through Highways.

THIS BY-LAW shall go into effect immediately upon the passing thereof.
