BY-LAW NUMBER 616

BEING a By-law to provide for the appointment of an Engineer in the Town of North Bay, and to define the duties of the said Engineer.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Town of North Bay deem it advisable to pass a By-law appointing a Town Engineer and to define the duties of the said Engineer,

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of North Bay, enacts as follows:

1. That F.G. MACZIE is hereby appointed Engineer for the Town of North Bay, on a salary of Twenty-^{Five}~~Seven~~ Hundred Dollars, (\$~~27~~²⁵00.00), per year, the said salary to be paid in semi-monthly installments, each month during the continuance of the employment.

2. That the said Engineer shall devote his whole time and attention to the business of the Town and not engage in any other business or occupation of any kind, whatsoever, and will attend to the duties of his Office between the hours of nine o'clock and twelve o'clock in the forenoon, and one-thirty o'clock in the afternoon, till six o'clock, on all days except Sundays and legal holidays, and the said Engineer will be ready at any time and all time, during the day or night, when called on by the Mayor or Council, to attend to any matter of importance, requiring immediate attention. The said Engineer will countersign all requisitions for material required, and must give account of all material, tools and property of the Corporation, and give an annual Statement thereof. The said Engineer is to perform all engineering work required to be performed by the Town Council, on Municipal Works.

3. The said Engineer shall attend all meetings of Council except excused by the Mayor, and will prepare all plans, profiles and estimates required by the Council; to supervise all works whatsoever, also works connected with the maintenance of streets, sewer pavements, water supply, pumping station and water distribution. The said Engineer will have charge of all men connected with the several works enumerated above.

Read a first and second time in Open Council, this 16th day of May.
