

BY-LAW NUMBER 917

BEING A BY-LAW to authorize the Transfer of Part of the North Half of The South Half of Lot Seventeen (17) in Concession "C" of the Township of Widdifield and known as Parcel No.2969 in the Register for Widdifield and Ferris, To His Majesty the King as represented by G. Howard Ferguson Acting Minister of Public Works, for the Province of Ontario.

WHEREAS it is deemed meet that certain property herein named be transferred to the Crown, in the right of the Province of Ontario, for the purpose of erecting a goal for the District of Nipissing, it is therefore enacted as follows:

1. THAT the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) do by their proper officers transfer and convey to His Majesty the King as represented by G. Howard Ferguson, Acting Minister of Public Works for the Province of Ontario, all their right, title and interest in the property hereinafter mentioned, that is to say:

Part of the North Half of the South Half of Lot Number Seventeen (17) in Concession "C" of the said Township of Widdifield described as follows: Commencing at a point in the Northerly limit of the Trout Lake Road where the same is intersected by the Westerly limit of the said lot; thence Northerly along the said Westerly limit of the Lot Nine (9) chains fifteen (15) links; thence Easterly at right angles to the Westerly limit of the said lot, five (5) chains and forty-one links; thence South Sixteen feet, thirty inches East magnetically, six chains, nine links more or less to a point in the Northerly limit of the road aforementioned, which part is eight chains and seventy-five links from the place of beginning measured Easterly from the Northerly limit of the said road allowance; thence Westerly along the Northerly limit of the said road allowance eight chains and seventy-five links to the place of beginning, containing by measurement five acres more or less and known as Parcel Number 2969 in the Register for Widdifield and Ferris.

2. THAT WHEREAS electric light, telephone and water service facilities run along the highway immediately adjoining the property conveyed, the Municipality will assist in having connections made thereto and will insure rates identical with those charged in the City of North Bay as set out in attached letters from the Hydro Electric Power Commission dated February 15th, 1929 and The Bell Telephone Company of Canada dated February 2nd, 1929.

3. THAT if and when the Municipality of the City of North Bay installs a sewage system for that section of the Municipality the said Municipality will permit the Crown to connect thereto and will allow the disposal of sewage from the jail property through the City sewers free of charge.
