

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 81-96

BEING A BY-LAW TO ALTER OSCAR STREET
BETWEEN LAKESHORE DRIVE AND LAKE
NIPISSING IN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY.

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and in the interest of The Corporation of the City of North Bay that Oscar Street between Lakeshore Drive and Lake Nipissing be altered.

AND WHEREAS notice of this By-law was published once a week for four consecutive weeks in the North Bay Nugget, published in the City of North Bay;

AND WHEREAS no person has claimed that his lands will be prejudicially affected by the passing of this by-law nor applied to be heard in person or by his counsel, solicitor or agent, by the Council of the said City or a Committee of said Council.


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. All of Oscar Street, Plan 36 M-211, lying between Lakeshore Drive and Lake Nipissing is hereby altered by the placement of a barrier along 220 feet to divide the north part from the south part as shown on Schedule "A".
2. This By-Law shall come into effect upon being approved by the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing and registered in the Land Registry Office for the District of Nipissing.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 6TH DAY OF AUGUST, 1996.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 6TH DAY OF AUGUST, 1996.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 26TH DAY OF AUGUST, 1996.

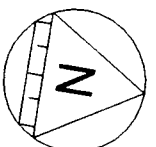
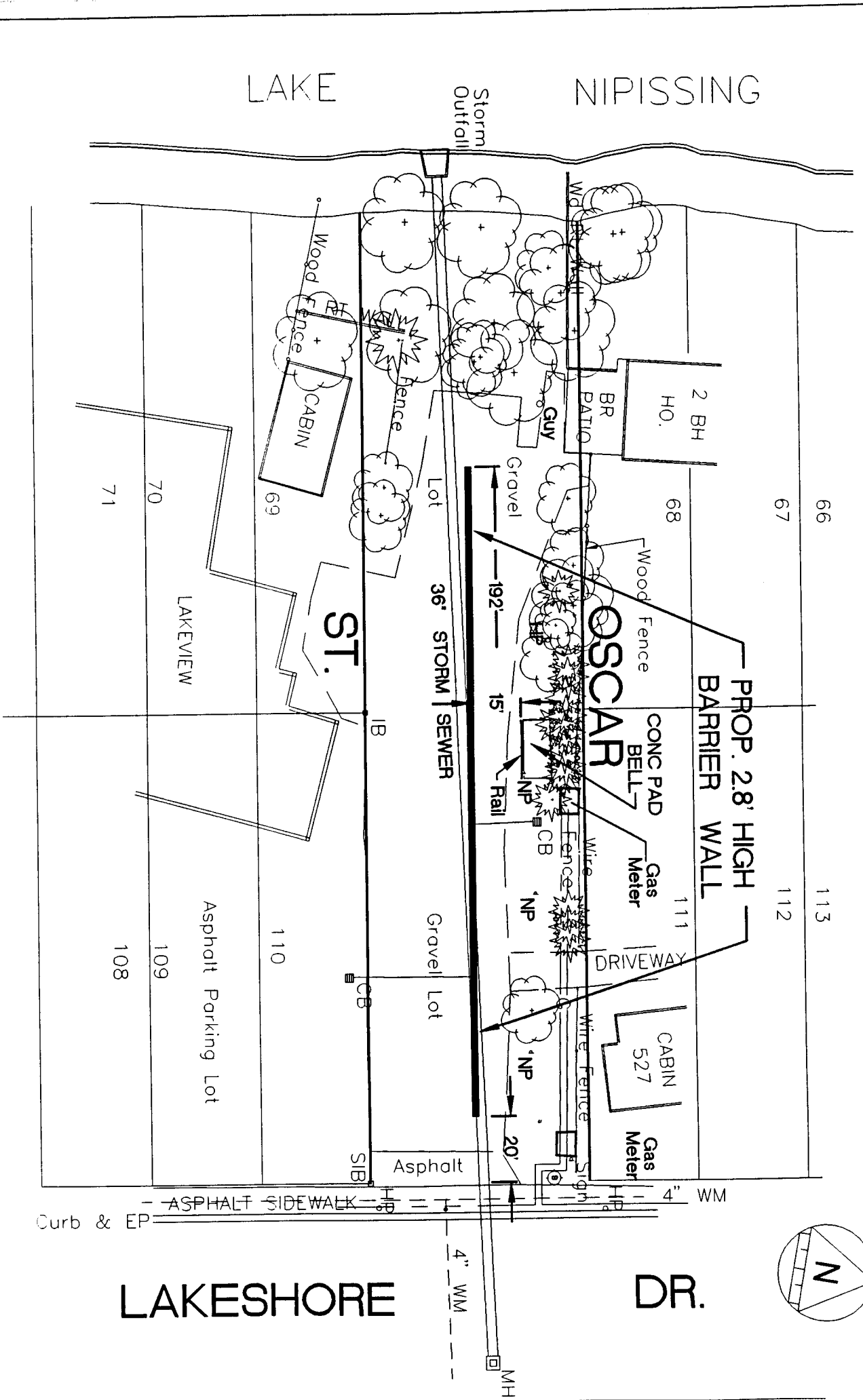
