

By Law 594

BY-LAW NUMBER 594

BEING a By-law to authorize the levting of a rate of taxation for the Town of North Bay, to meet the necessary expenditures for the year 1920.

WHEREAS it is necessary that a sufficient amount of money be raised by taxation, to meet the necessary expenses of the Town of North Bay, for the year 1920,

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED, and it is hereby enacted by the Municipal Council of the Town of North Bay as follows:-

- 1. That a rate of 23 $\frac{6}{10}$ mills on the dollar for general purposes be levied on all taxable property of the Municipality of the said Town of North Bay, as per the Assessment Roll for the year 1920, as finally revised and passed.
- 2. That a rate of 4 $\frac{4}{10}$ on the dollar for Collegiate Institute purposes be levied on all the taxable property of the Municipality of the said Town of North Bay, as per the Assessment Roll for the year 1920, as finally revised and passed.
- 3. That a rate of 12 mills on the dollar for Public School purposes be levied on all the taxable property of the Public School supporters in the Municipality of the said Town of North Bay, as per the Assessment Roll for the year 1920, as finally revised and passed.
- 4. That a rate of 12 mills on the dollar for Separate School purposes be levied on all the taxable property of the Separate School supporters in the Municipality of the Town of North Bay, as per the Assessment Roll for the year 1920, as finally revised and passed.
