

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 2004-213

**BEING A BY-LAW TO STOP UP, CLOSE AND CONVEY
A PORTION OF THE UNOPENED PORTION OF HIGHWAY 63
ALONG TROUT LAKE ROAD, ABUTTING PART LOT 15, CONCESSION "C",
IN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY**

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and in the interest of The Corporation of the City of North Bay that part of the unopened portion of Highway 63 along Trout Lake Road abutting Part Lot 15, Concession "C", be closed, stopped up and sold to the abutting owners;

AND WHEREAS the unopened portion of Highway 63 along Trout Lake Road abutting Part Lot 15, Concession "C", is hereby declared to be surplus;

AND WHEREAS notice of this by-law was published once a week for two consecutive weeks in the North Bay Nugget, published in the City of North Bay;

AND WHEREAS no person has claimed that his lands will be prejudicially affected by the passing of this by-law nor applied to be heard in person or by his counsel, solicitor, or agent, the Council of the City nor a Committee of said Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That certain part of the unopened portion of Highway 63 along Trout Lake Road abutting Part Lot 15, Concession "C", designated as Parts 1, 2 & 3 on Reference Plan 36R-11785 is hereby closed, stopped up and conveyed.
2. The City shall transfer Parts 1, 2 & 3, Plan 36R-11785 to the owners of the lands abutting thereon, their successors or assigns.
3. This by-law comes into force and effect upon a certified copy of the by-law being registered in the Land Titles Office for the District of Nipissing.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 13TH DAY OF DECEMBER, 2004.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THE 17TH DAY OF JANUARY, 2005.
