

BY-LAW NO. 112-75

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 42-70 BEING A BY-LAW AMENDING BY-LAW NO. 1097 OF THE FORMER TOWNSHIP OF WIDDIFIELD PURSUANT TO SECTION 30 OF THE PLANNING ACT, R.S.O. 1970, AND AMENDMENTS THERETO.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay authorized by Resolution No. 47 passed at its regular meeting held 22 September, 1975 that paragraph 3 of By-law No. 42-70 be deleted.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That paragraph 3 of By-law No. 42-70 which is quoted hereunder be and is hereby deleted.

Paragraph 3, By-law No. 42-70:

112-12

"The establishment by this By-law of the Restricted Industrial District Special 2-70 Zone is by way of recognition of an industry presently located therein. The establishment of any new industry therein and any expansion of the existing industrial building are prohibited."

2. This By-law shall come into full force and effect upon the final passing thereof subject to the approval of The Ontario Municipal Board.
