

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 2220

Being a by-law to repeal By-law No. 2107 of the Corporation of the City of North Bay regulating and governing the owners of Barber Shops and requiring the closing of Barber Shops during certain hours.

WHEREAS the matter of the closing of Barber Shops within the City of North Bay is governed by The Industrial Standards Act, R.S.S. 1960, Chapter 186, as amended, including Regulations made thereunder.

AND WHEREAS by reason of the foregoing, By-law No. 2107 of the Corporation of the City of North Bay is ultra vires, illegal and void.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. That By-law No. 2107 of the Corporation of the City of North Bay be and the same is hereby repealed.
