

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 2007-106

BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE ALTERING
OF CHIPPEWA STREET

WHEREAS Section 34(2) of *the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 2001* authorizes that Council pass By-Laws for widening, altering or diverting any highway.

AND WHEREAS it is desirable to alter Chippewa Street at the By-Pass.

AND WHEREAS notice of this By-Law has been published at least once a week for two consecutive weeks and the Council has heard any person who claims that his lands will be prejudicially affected by the By-Law and who has applied to be heard.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That part of Chippewa Street, Plan M177, Designated as Part 6, Plan 36R-12023 in the City of North Bay, is to be altered to erect an aerial pedestrian walkway bridge over Highway 11 By-Pass.
2. This By-Law comes into force and effect upon passing.
