

BY-LAW NO. 2257


BEING A BY-LAW to appoint a Board to administer the Community Centre known as The Community Memorial Building.

WHEREAS in compliance with the Community Centres Act, being Chapter 60, R.S.O. 1960 and the regulations thereunder, it is necessary to appoint annually a Board to administer said Community Centre.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. That in compliance with the Community Centres Act, being Chapter 60, R.S.O. 1960 and the regulations thereunder, and in compliance with Resolution No. 2 of the Council meeting held Monday, January 24th, 1966, the following named Board was duly appointed for the year 1966.
 - (1) Mr. A. Lafrance (Jr) (4) Ald. F. Chirico
 - (2) Mr. C. Earl Dillon (5) Ald. D.J. Morland (Jr.)
 - (3) Mr. Alan Jackson (Jr.)
2. That the Board thus named be hereby approved and appointed, which Board shall be known as The Community Memorial Building Commission.
3. That By-law No. 2187 is hereby repealed and all other By-laws inconsistent with this by-law be hereby amended.
4. That the said Community Centre shall be maintained as a Community Centre by the said Board in conformity with the Act and regulations made thereunder.


