

BY-LAW NO. 1595

BEING a By-Law of the Corporation of the City of North Bay to provide for the submission of certain By-Laws for the assent of qualified electors of the City of North Bay and to appoint a day on which to take a vote thereon and to name places where the votes are to be taken and to appoint Deputy Returning Officers to take a vote at every such place.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay deems it advisable to submit to the vote of electors of the Corporation qualified to vote on Money By-Laws the following proposed Money By-Laws.

(a) A By-Law to provide for Curb Removal and Road Widening on certain streets, namely:-

Main Street W.	N. W. Cor.	Main St. at Bye St.
Main Street W.	South Side	At curve opposite Bye St.
Jane Street	North W. Corner	From a point opposite High School Building to Algonquin Avenue.
McIntyre Street	South Sides	Bye Street easterly to Fisher Street.

and to provide for the borrowing of \$50,000.00 for that purpose.

(b) A By-Law to authorize City Council to make an annual Grant to the Community Recreational Council in an amount equal to ONE MILL on the General Taxable Assessment of the Municipality.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. There shall be submitted to the electors of the Municipal Corporation of North Bay qualified to vote on Money By-Laws the following proposed By-Laws entitled:

(a) Being a By-Law to provide for Curb Removal and Road Widening on certain streets, namely:-

McIntyre Street	South Sides	Bye Street easterly to Fisher Street.

(b) Being a By-Law to authorize City Council to make an annual Grant to the Community Recreational Council in an amount equal to ONE MILL on the General Taxable Assessment of the Municipality.

2. A copy of each of the aboved proposed By-Laws is attached hereto and marked exhibit A and B respectively and forms part of this By-Law.

3. That the votes of the said electors shall be taken on the said By-Laws at the same time and places and by the Deputy Returning Officers and Poll

Clerks, at the Annual Municipal Elections.

4. That a true copy of the proposed By-Laws shall be published in the North Bay Nugget on the days hereinafter mentioned, that is to say, on the eighth, fifteenth and twenty-second days of November 1950.

5. On the 29th day of November at his office in the Council Chambers, on Ferguson Street, in the City of North Bay, at 2 o'clock in the afternoon, the Mayor will in writing signed by him appoint two persons to attend the Final Summing Up of the Votes by the Clerk of this Corporation, and one persons to attend each Polling Place on behalf of the persons interested in and desirous of promoting the proposed Money By-Laws, and a like number on behalf of the persons interested in and desirous of opposing the proposed Money By-Laws.

6. The thirteenth day of December at the said Council Chambers at twelve o'clock in the forenoon is hereby appointed as the time and place for summing up, by the Clerk of this Corporation of the number of votes given in the affirmative and in the negative, respectively.
