

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 151-81

BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE SALE OF
LANDS NO LONGER REQUIRED FOR MUNICIPAL
PURPOSES.

WHEREAS Section 193 (1) of The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980,
Chapter 302 provides that the Council may pass by-laws for
selling lands no longer required for municipal purposes.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF
NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That The Corporation of the City of North Bay
transfer and sell to Angelo Cappadocia, his
heirs, executors, successors and assigns, that
Part of Lot 17, Plan 47 in the City of North
Bay, designated as Part 8, Plan NR-1563 upon
the receipt of the sum of One Thousand Dollars
(\$1,000.00).
2. That the Mayor and Clerk of The Corporation of
the City of North Bay be and they are hereby
authorized to execute that certain Transfer to
Angelo Cappadocia dated September 21, 1981.
3. This by-law comes into force and effect upon
being finally passed.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 21ST DAY OF SEPTEMBER , 1981.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 5th DAY OF OCTOBER , 1981.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 5th
DAY OF OCTOBER , 1981.
