

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 140-70

BEING A BY-LAW GRANTING TO MR. MELVILLE BODEN, A RETIRED EMPLOYEE OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY, AN ANNUAL RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE DURING HIS LIFE, TO TAKE EFFECT NOVEMBER 1, 1970.

WHEREAS The Municipal Act of the Province of Ontario, R.S.O. 1960, Chapter 249, Section 240, provides that a Council may grant an annual retirement allowance to an employee during his life who has had continuous service for at least twenty (20) years with the municipality, or with any other municipality or local board as referred to therein, or any two or more of them, upon and subject to the terms and conditions therein set forth;

AND WHEREAS the said Melville Boden qualifies for such allowance pursuant to the said Section.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That effective November 1, 1970 the said Melville Boden be granted an annual retirement allowance of \$3,165.20 during his life, payable in monthly instalments of \$263.77 provided that the said annual sum of \$3,165.20 will be reduced in respect of any year by the amount of income accruing to the said Melville Boden in such year by way of investment income and/or pension payments, both exclusive of such to which he was entitled as of November 1, 1970.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 16TH DAY OF NOVEMBER, 1970.  
READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND FINALLY ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 16TH DAY OF NOVEMBER, 1970.
