THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 50-82

BEING A BY-LAW TO DISPOSE OF LANDS NO LONGER REQUIRED FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES.

WHEREAS section 193 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, chapter 302 provides that the Council may pass by-laws for disposing of lands no longer required for municipal purposes.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Corporation of the City of North Bay is hereby authorized and directed to transfer to Prowood Holdings all of Block B, according to Registered Plan M-465 in the City of North Bay upon receipt of the sum of \$1,000.00, subject to an interest in the nature of an easement for operating, maintaining, repairing and reconstructing a storm sewer.
- 2. The Corporation of the City of North Bay is hereby authorized and directed to transfer to Prowood Holdings all of Block C, according to Registered Plan M-465 upon receipt of the consideration of the sum of \$1,000.00 subject to an interest in the nature of an easement for operating, maintaining, repairing and reconstructing a storm sewer.
- 3. The Mayor and Clerk of The Corporation of the City of North

 Bay are hereby authorized and directed to execute Transfers

 to Prowood Holdings dated March 4, 1982, accordingly.
- 4. This By-law comes into force and effect upon being finally passed.
