

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 150-89

BEING A BY-LAW TO STOP UP AND CLOSE A PORTION  
OF BARBER AVENUE IN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY.

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and in the interest of The Corporation of the City of North Bay those parts of the street hereinafter described be closed and stopped up;

AND WHEREAS notice of this by-law was published once a week for four consecutive weeks in the North Bay Nugget, published in the City of North Bay.

AND WHEREAS no person has claimed that his lands will be prejudicially affected by the passing of this by-law nor applied to be heard in person or by his counsel, solicitor or agent, by the Council of the said City or a Committee of said Council.


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That certain part of Barber Avenue abutting Parcel 12924, Nipissing, shown as Part 1 on a Reference Plan of Survey, prepared by P. A. Blackburn, Ontario Land Surveyor, dated July 18, 1989, is hereby closed and stopped up.
2. That certain part of Barber Avenue abutting part of Lot 6 and Lots 7 to 12, shown as Part 2 on a Reference Plan of Survey prepared by P. A. Blackburn, Ontario Land Surveyor, dated July 18, 1989, is hereby closed and stopped up.
3. The Corporation of the City of North Bay is hereby authorized and directed to sell the soil and freehold of that part of the Barber Avenue road allowance, designated as Parts 1 and 2 of the said reference plan to the abutting registered owner of Parcel 12924, Nipissing and part of Lot 6 and Lots 7 to 12, their assessors and assigns.
4. This by-law comes into force and effect upon a certified copy of this by-law being registered in the Land Registry Office for the District of Nipissing.
