By Law No. 2015-38

A By-law to Designate a Site Plan Control Area on Certain Lands on College Drive

Nipissing University

Whereas the Council of The Corporation of the City of North Bay, hereinafter referred to as “Council”, deems it desirable to designate a Site Plan Control Area in the City of North Bay pursuant to Section 41 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13 as amended;

And Whereas Council deems it desirable to delegate to the Chief Administrative Officer the authority to enter into an agreement respecting the matters referred to herein;

And Whereas Council intends to pass By-law No. 2015-38 to rezone the subject lands to an “Institutional (N)” zone to permit the construction of a Student Union Building.

Now Therefore the Council of The Corporation of the City of North Bay hereby enacts as follows:

- 1) That certain parcel of land composed of PIN # 49129-0001, Parcel 10991, sec W&F; Part of Lot 22, Concession B, Widdifield, Part 1, 36R2771, except Part 1, 36R6171; s/t LT138949, LT77546, City of North Bay, in the District of Nipissing, which lands are more particularly described on Schedule "A" attached hereto, is hereby designated as a Site Plan Control Area.
- 2) As a condition of approval, all buildings or structures and parking facilities shall be provided and maintained in a location that is satisfactory to The Corporation of the City of North Bay (hereinafter referred to as “the City”).
- 3) As a condition of approval the owner agrees to provide a storm water management plan which shall include a lot grading plan for the subject property. Said storm water management plan shall be prepared, and any resulting alteration to the subject lands shall occur, to the satisfaction of the City Engineer and at no expense to the City.
- 4) As a condition of approval of buildings and structures referred to in Section 2 hereof, no building or structure shall be erected, constructed, or placed on said Site Plan Control Area until the owner of the Site Plan Control Area has entered into an agreement with the City respecting the provisions, to the satisfaction of and at no expense to the City of the following matters:
 - a) parking facilities and access driveways and the surfacing of such areas and driveways;
 - b) walkways and the surfacing thereof;

- c) facilities for lighting, including floodlighting;
 - d) walls, fences, hedges, trees or shrubs, or other groundcover or facilities for the landscaping of the lands;
 - e) collection areas and other facilities and enclosures for the storage of garbage and other waste material;
 - f) grading or alteration in elevation or contour of the land and provision for the disposal of storm, surface and waste water from the land and from any buildings or structures thereon; and
 - g) adequate water supply for fire fighting purposes.
- 5) The Chief Administrative Officer is hereby authorized to enter into, under Corporate Seal, one or more agreements on behalf of the City with the owner of the subject lands herein to ensure the provision of all the facilities mentioned in this By-law, and to impose a fee as set out in the City of North Bay User Fee By-law upon the owner for preparation.
- 6) The said Agreement may be registered against the lands to which it applies and the City may enforce the provisions of the *Registry Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. R.20 or any successor legislation thereto and the *Land Titles Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. L.5 or any successor legislation thereto against any and all subsequent owners of the land.
- 7) The said Agreement shall be binding on the owner, its successors, assigns and heirs.
- 8) Pursuant to the provisions of Section 446 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c.25 and Section 41(11) of the *Planning Act*, in the event that the owner fails to do any matter or thing required by said Agreement, the City may take action to ensure that the matter or thing shall be done at the owner's expense, and all other provisions of Section 446 of the *Municipal Act, 2011* shall apply.
- 9) This By-law comes into force and effect upon being finally passed.
