THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 144-92

BEING A BY-LAW TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE A PORTION OF FRASER STREET FROM MAIN STREET TO ALGONQUIN AVENUE.

WHEREAS pursuant to the request of the Downtown Improvement Area, it is deemed expedient to temporarily close a portion of Fraser Street from Main Street to Algonquin Avenue, pursuant to the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M-45, Section 207, Subsection 44.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the portion of Fraser Street from Main Street to Algonquin Avenue in the City of North Bay be and the same is hereby closed from 10:00 o'clock in the forenoon until 2:00 o'clock in the afternoon on Friday, June 26, 1992, for the purpose of a downtown promotion.
- 2. If it is necessary to cancel the above closure due to inclement weather, then the closure will take place on July 3, 1992 at the same times.
- 3. That the Director of Transportation and Works is hereby authorized to have barricades and warning devices erected to carry out the said closure.
- 4. That prior to 3:00 o'clock in the afternoon on the 26th day of June, 1992, the Director of Transportation and Works will attend to the restoration of the said portion of Fraser Street to its condition prior to the above closure.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 22ND DAY OF JUNE, 1992.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 22ND DAY OF JUNE, 1992.
