

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 119-75

BEING A BY-LAW TO REGULATE THE KEEPING OF FOWL OR ANIMALS AND THE KEEPING OF KENNELS FOR THE PURPOSES OF BREEDING OR BOARDING ANY FOWL OR ANIMAL WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY.

WHEREAS authority is granted under Section 354 of The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 284, to pass this By-law;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay deems it advisable and expedient to enact the within By-law.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. No person within any "Residential District" as established by By-law No. 1097 of the former Township of Widdifield and amendments thereto or within any "Residential Use Zone" as established by By-law No. 9-69 of the former City of North Bay and amendments thereto or within any "Residential Zone", "Highway and Tourist Commercial Zone" or "Highway and Tourist Commercial 2 Zone" as established by By-law No. 907 of the former Township of West Ferris and amendments thereto, shall keep any domestic fowl, cattle, goats, swine, horses, sheep, mink or foxes; nor shall any person keep any kennels for the purpose of breeding or boarding either cats or dogs.
2. This By-law shall be administered by the Director of Planning or such person or persons as he may designate from time to time.
3. Any violation of this By-law shall constitute an offence and shall be punishable upon summary conviction of a fine not exceeding three hundred (\$300.00) dollars.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 3RD DAY OF NOVEMBER, 1975.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 17TH DAY OF NOVEMBER, 1975.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND FINALLY ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 1ST DAY OF DECEMBER , 1975.
