BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 111-77 BEING A BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE SCHOOL BUS LOADING ZONES IN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That Schedule "A" attached thereto and forming part of By-law No. 111-77 be deleted and that Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this by-law be inserted in lieu thereof.
- That this by-law shall come into full force and effect upon the final passing thereof.
