BY-LAW NO. 14-92

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 57-89

WHEREAS it is desirable to amend By-law No. 57-89 to accommodate enforcement of set fines under the Provincial Offences Act;


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Paragraph 3 of section 27 of North Bay By-law No. 57-89 is hereby deleted and the following inserted in lieu thereof:
27. (3) (a) No person shall park a vehicle at any parking meter zone during the applicable days and hours described in Schedule 18 to this by-law:
 - (i) unless and until there is deposited in the appropriate parking meter a fee of one (1) five cent (5) coin, one (1) ten cent (10) coin or one (1) twenty-five cent (25) coin for the period of authorized parking described in Schedule 18;
 - (ii) the parking meter is activated; and
 - (iii) in no case longer than the maximum authorized parking time at that parking meter as stipulated in Schedule 18.
- (b) No person shall park a vehicle in a parking meter zone described in Schedule 18 to this by-law unless to make use of the parking meter immediately adjacent to the parking space within which such vehicle is parked and unless the fee set by Schedule 18 of this by-law is paid by the driver of the vehicle.
- (c) (i) Parallel Parking - No person shall park a vehicle in a parking meter zone unless the front bumper of the vehicle is adjacent to a single parking meter, or the front or rear bumper, as indicated on the appropriate parking meter, is adjacent to a double parking meter.
- (ii) Angle Parking - No person shall park a vehicle in a parking meter zone unless the front bumper of the vehicle is parked adjacent to the appropriate parking meter.
