

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 68-76

BEING A BY-LAW TO RETAIN COUNSEL TO THE MUNICIPALITY IN THE PENDING PROCEEDINGS BEFORE THE ONTARIO POLICE COMMISSION BROUGHT BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF POLICE FOR THE CITY OF NORTH BAY AND TO RETAIN WILLIAM KELLY TO MAKE SUCH INVESTIGATIONS AND REPORTS AS MAY BE REQUIRED BY COUNSEL.


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Mr. Earl A. Cherniak be and is hereby retained as counsel to the municipality in the pending proceedings before the Ontario Police Commission brought by the Board of Commissioners of Police for the City of North Bay.
2. That Mr. William Kelly be and is hereby retained to make such investigations and reports as may be requested by Mr. Earl A. Cherniak and to advise and assist Mr. Cherniak.
3. This by-law shall become effective upon the final passing thereof.
