THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 66-79

BEING A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE MONEYS FOR EMER-GENCY MEASURES AND TO AUTHORIZE THE CONS-TRUCTION OF SUCH WORKS AS MAY BE CONSIDERED NECESSARY FOR THE PURPOSE OF PREVENTING DAMAGE TO PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY BY FLOODS.

WHEREAS The Municipal Act provides that by-laws may be passed by Council

- (a) for the health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the municipality;
- (b) for the purpose of preventing damage to any property within the municipality by floods arising from the overflowing or damming back of a river, stream or creek flowing through or in the neighbourhood of the municipality and for constructing such works as may be considered necessary; and
- (c) for providing moneys for emergency measures within the municipality

AND WHEREAS in the opinion of the Council of The Corporation of the City of North Bay it is necessary to provide moneys for emergency measures, to protect the inhabitants and to prevent damage to property by reason of the floods arising from Parks Creek and Lake Nipissing.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That an amount up to \$100,000.00 is hereby provided for emergency measures to be taken to construct works and dikes of sand or sandbags to prevent damage to property by reason of floods arising from Parks Creek and along the shores of Lake Nipissing in the City of North Bay.
- The said works and dikes are to be constructed under the supervision of the Director of Planning and Works.
- 3. This by-law shall come into force upon being finally passed.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 1ST DAY OF MAY , 1979. READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 1ST DAY OF MAY , 1979. READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND FINALLY ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 1ST DAY OF MAY , 1979.
