BY-LAW NO. 1291

BEING A BY-LAW of the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay to close certain streets within the said City of North Bay.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay have been requested and upon consideration, deem it advisable to close the following streets:- Gorman Street, Wharf Street and Mill Street being all the streets shown on Plans ~~M-175~~ ^{land titles filed in the Office of Land Titles at North Bay, and to convey the streets upon their being closed up to The Sisters of St. Joseph of the Diocese of Sault Ste. Marie, who are the owners of all of the lots from 1 to 80 inclusive abutting on the said streets.} *OK sel*

THEREFORE under and by virtue of the authority vested in the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay by The Municipal Act, being R.S.O. 1937, Sections 495 and 496 Chapter 266, The COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. THAT the following streets:- Gorman Street, Wharf Street and Mill Street being all the streets ^{lying south of the Canadian Pacific Railway as shown on Plans M-175} filed in the Office of Land Titles at North Bay be, and the same are hereby closed and stopped up.

Canadian Pacific Railway as OK H. L. P.

2. THAT forthwith upon this By-Law taking effect the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay shall convey the said streets as closed and stopped up under the next preceding section to The Sisters of St. Joseph of the Diocese of Sault Ste. Marie for the consideration of the sum of \$55.60.

3. THAT the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay shall hear in person or by his or her solicitor, counsel or agent, any person who claims that his or her lands will be prejudicially affected by this By-Law, and who applies to be heard.

4. THAT this By-Law shall take effect upon the passing thereof and after notice of the same has been published once a week for four consecutive weeks as provided by the Statutes in that behalf.

READ a First Time in Open Council this 4th. day of April, 1938.

READ a Second Time in Open Council this 2nd. day of May, 1938.

Rules of Order were suspended and By-Law was read a Third Time short and Passed this 2nd. day of May, 1938.
