

BY-LAW NO. 2051

BEING A BY-LAW of the Corporation of the City of North Bay for closing parts of Lorne Avenue and certain lanes lying between Aubrey Street and Olive Street in the City of North Bay as shown on NR Plan-332 filed in the Office of Land Titles at North Bay.

WHEREAS THE Council of the City of North Bay deems it advisable to close certain parts of the street and lanes above mentioned and more particularly described below, and to sell and convey the same to the owner of the lands adjoining same.

AND WHEREAS notice of the intention of this Corporation to close same has been published once a week for four consecutive weeks in the local newspaper.

AND WHEREAS the said Council has undertaken to hear in person or by their counsel, solicitor or agent, any person who claims that his or her lands will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applies to be heard.


NOW THEREFORE THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That all and singular those certain parcels and tracts of lands and premises situate lying and being in the City of North Bay in the District of Nipissing and being composed of parts 2, 3, 5 and 8 shown on Plan NR-332 filed in the Office of Land Titles at North Bay, Ontario, be and the same are hereby closed and stopped up.
2. That the said Parts 2 and 5, be sold and conveyed to Great Northern Realty & Mfg. Company Limited or its assignee.
