

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 179-79

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 46-73
BEING A BY-LAW TO REGULATE THE KEEPING AND
CONTROL OF ANIMALS; THE LICENSING AND
RESTRAINT; TAKING UP AND IMPOUNDMENT;
DESTRUCTION OF DOGS IN CERTAIN INSTANCES
AND OTHER MATTERS OF ANIMAL CONTROL WITHIN
THE CITY OF NORTH BAY.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF
NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. By-law No. 46-73 be amended by deleting Section 1,
subsection (1) and the following inserted in
lieu thereof:

"(1) "At large" means that a dog shall be deemed
to be running at large when found in any
place other than the premises of the owner
of the dog and not under the control of any
person."

2. By-law No. 46-73 be amended by adding the following
section:

"8. Nothing in this by-law confers the right of
any person to enter any premises."

3. That Schedule "B", Section 3 of By-law No. 46-73
be amended by adding to Section 3 thereof the
following sub-section:


"(d) Upon payment of a boarding fee of \$3.00 per
day after the first day of impoundment."

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 15th DAY OF October ,1979.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND FINALLY ENACTED AND PASSED
THIS 15th DAY OF October ,1979.
