
BY-LAW NO. 21-73

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 20-72
BEING A BY-LAW TO REGULATE THE OPERATION
OF MOTORIZED SNOW VEHICLES WITHIN THE CITY
OF NORTH BAY.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Section 1 of By-law No. 20-72 is hereby repealed and is replaced with the following:
 - 1. For the purposes of this By-law:
 - (a) "City" means the City of North Bay.
 - (b) "Motorized Snow Vehicle" means a self-propelled vehicle designed to be driven exclusively on snow or ice or both.
 - (c) "Highway" means a highway as defined in The Highway Traffic Act.
 - (d) "Park" or "Parking" when prohibited, means park or parking as defined in The Highway Traffic Act.
 - (e) "Public Laneway" means any lands vested in the City and laid out in the rear of lands abutting on another highway or to any outlet connecting such a lane with a highway and designed and intended for, or used by, the general public for either the passage of vehicles or as a pedestrian walkway.
 - (f) "Vehicle" means a vehicle as defined in The Highway Traffic Act.
- 2. Section 2 of By-law No. 20-72 is hereby repealed and is replaced with the following:
 - 2. No person shall bring into or use, drive, operate, draw, haul or propel a motorized snow vehicle along or upon any sidewalk, pathway, footpath, public laneway or other pedestrian way used by or set apart for the use of pedestrians within the limits of the City.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 19TH DAY OF FEBRUARY, 1973.
READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 5TH DAY OF MARCH, 1973.
READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND FINALLY ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 5TH DAY OF MARCH, 1973.
