THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 134-93

BEING A BY-LAW TO STOP UP AND CLOSE KINGSWAY AVENUE.

WHEREAS Kingsway Avenue on Registered Plan 36M-293 was extended southerly to provide a second access to Northgate Square during its construction in 1979;

AND WHEREAS the City of North Bay has assumed the Kingsway Avenue extension as a public road by regularly spending public funds for the purpose of maintaining public travel on the Kingsway Avenue extension for more than 10 years;

AND WHEREAS it is now deemed desirable to close the Kingsway Avenue extension by erecting barriers on the lands described as Parts 1 and 2 on Reference Plan 36R-9632 and Part 1 on Reference Plan 36R-9633.

AND WHEREAS notice of this By-Law was published once a week for four consecutive weeks in the North Bay Nugget, published in the City of North Bay.

AND WHEREAS any person who claims that his lands will be prejudicially affected by the passing of this By-Law has been heard in person by his counsel, solicitor or agent, by the Council of the said City.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS.

- 1. That certain assumed road being the extension of Kingsway Avenue, Registered Plan 36M-293 in the City of North Bay in the District of Nipissing is hereby closed and stopped up from Parts 1 and 2 on Reference Plan 36R-9632 to Part 1 on Reference Plan 36R-9633.
- 2. This By-Law comes into force and effect upon a certified copy of this By-Law being registered in the Land Registry Office for the District of Nipissing.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 4TH DAY OF JANUARY XXXX. 1994.
