BY-LAW NO. 1773

BEING A BY-LAW to regulate the sounding of locomotive whistles within the Corporate limits of the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS many citizens have petitioned the Municipal Council to pass a By-law to eliminate the whistling of locomotives within the limits of the City of North Bay.

THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY in accordance with the provisions of Section 311 (formerly Section 306) Sub-section (2) of the Railway Act, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The sounding of any engine whistle in accordance with the provisions of Section 311(1) of the Railway Act, in respect of any highway crossing within the limits of the City of North Bay is hereby prohibited.
- 2. This By-law shall come into force if and when approved by an Order of the Board of Transport Commissioners for Canada.
