## THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

## BY-LAW NO. 51-83

BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN IN RIGHT OF ONTARIO AS REPRESENTED BY THE MINISTER OF THE ENVIRONMENT RELATING TO THE SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT.

WHEREAS under subsection 7 (2) and Section 8 of the Ontario Water Resources Act, R.S.O. 1980, the Council of a Municipality may, by by-law, authorize the Municipality to enter into an agreement with the Crown for the reception, treatment and disposal of sewage for the Municipality.

AND WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of North Bay wishes to enter into an agreement with the Crown providing for the operation, supervision, control, maintenance, repair, administration and insuring by the Crown of certain sewage works owned by the Municipality. The Corporation of the City of North Bay by its Municipal Council, enacts as a by-law of the Corporation as follows:

- The Corporation of the City of North Bay is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement, in the form annexed hereto as Schedule "A", with Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Ontario as represented by the Minister of the Environment.
- The Mayor and Clerk be and they are hereby authorized to execute the said agreement, a copy of which is attached hereto, as Schedule "A", and any other documents necessary to carry out the intention of the parties.
- This by-law is subject to the approval of the Ontario Municipal Board and shall not come into effect until approval of By-law No. 52-83.
