**BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND TRAFFIC BY-LAW
NO. 131-93, SCHEDULE 21 (PARKING METER ZONES)
FOR A MAIN STREET TWO HOUR FREE PARKING ZONE**

Whereas the Municipal Act, **R.S.O. 1990**, Chapter M.45 authorizes the Council to **pass** by-laws regulating or prohibiting certain traffic on highways and regulating or prohibiting parking on a highways.

And Whereas Council wishes to implement a 3 month trial period for free parking on Main Street

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Traffic By-law **131-93** is hereby amended by inserting the following Section **30.1**
30.1 Section **30** (1) and **30** (3) (a) (i) and (ii) are hereby suspended for the streets described in Zone No. 4 on Schedule 21.
2. Section **30.1** (2) Schedule 21 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following Zone 4


3. This By-law shall be in force and effect from July 1, 2001 to September 30, 2001.
