BY-LAW NO. 53-95

BEING A BY-LAW TO OPEN UP PART OF McKEOWN AVENUE.

WHEREAS By-Law 11-94 was passed to close and stop up Parts 3, 4, 5 and 6 on Plan 36R-9675 in order to accommodate the realignment of McKeown Avenue.

AND WHEREAS Parts 3 and 5 were inadvertently included in error in the road closing and the adjacent owner consents to the laying out of the lands as a highway.

AND WHEREAS this By-Law is being presented to re-open the road and to maintain access to the adjacent properties.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. That certain road allowance, being the forced road known as "Old McKeown Avenue" and designated as Parts 3 and 5, Plan 36R-9675 is hereby opened as a public highway which shall be maintained by The Corporation of the City of North Bay for the purpose of public travel.
2. This By-Law comes into force upon a certified copy of this By-Law being registered in the Land Registry Office for the District of Nipissing.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 10TH DAY OF APRIL 1995.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 24TH DAY OF APRIL 1995.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THE 24TH DAY OF APRIL 1995.
