

BY LAW NUMBER 869.

BEING A BY-LAW to fix Polling Places and to appoint Deputy Returning Officers for the holding of a Municipal Election for the offices of Public School Trustees-Two (2) from each ward for the year 1928.

WHEREAS it is necessary to pass a By-law fixing Polling Places and appointing Deputy Returning Officers for the purpose of taking the vote of the Public School Electors to select ten (10) Public School Trustees -Two (2) from each of the five (5) Wards.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS: /

1. THAT Polling Place No. 1 for the purpose of said election shall be in Mr. W. Santary's Store, 384 Main Street West and G. H. Anderson is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.
2. That Polling Place No. 2 for the purpose of said election shall be in the Court House, Bye and McIntyre Streets and W. F. Roynon is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.
3. That Polling Place No. 3 for the purpose of said election shall be in Jas. Palangio's Store, 38 Front Street, and George Elmitt is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.
4. That Polling Place No. 4 for the purpose of said election shall be in the Hydro Electric Plant, Worthington and Cassells Street and W. E. Bishop is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.
5. That Polling Place No. 5 for the purpose of said election shall be in the City Hall, McIntyre and Ferguson Streets and Thomas Livsay is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.
6. That Polling Place No. 6 for the purpose of said election shall be in the Canadian Legion Club Rooms, McIntyre and Ferguson Streets and J. E. Lehman is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.
7. That Polling Place No. 7 for the purpose of said election shall be in the Orange Hall, Fisher and McIntyre Streets and E. R. Herbert is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.
8. That Polling Place No. 8 for the purpose of said election shall be in the Orange Hall, Fisher and McIntyre Streets and G. H. Newton is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.
9. That Polling Place No. 9 for the purpose of said election shall be in A. Orfanko's Store, 307 McIntyre Street East and M. R. Douglas is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.
10. That Polling Place No. 10 for the purpose of said election shall be at F. Lebel's Residence, 99 Hammond Street and L. R. Hume is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.
11. That Polling Place No. 11 for the purpose of said election shall be in the Orange Hall, Cassells Street between Third Avenue and Percy Street and T. H. Winters is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.

12. That Polling Place No. 12 for the purpose of said election shall be in Chirico's Store, 95 Front Street and V. B. Wilcock is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.

13. That Polling Place No. 13 for the purpose of said election shall be in St. Simon's Parish Hall, Cassells Street and King Street and E. C. Bebee is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.

14. That the Railway Employee's, Express Messengers and Commercial Travellers Advance Polling Place for the purpose of said election shall be in the City Hall, Ferguson and McIntyre Streets and A. C. Amos is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.
