

BY-LAW NUMBER 621.

BEING a By-law to amend By-law No. 5~~8~~<sup>8</sup>4, amending By-law No. 390, regulating the Closing of Shops in the Town of North Bay.

WHEREAS a petition has been presented to the Council of the said Town, signed by more than three-fourths in number of the occupiers of shops of the following class within the Municipality, namely - Shoe Repairing Shops - praying for certain amendments to said By-law No. 584,

AND WHEREAS IT IS DEEMED ADVISABLE to amend By-law No. 584, in accordance with the prayer of said petitioners,

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED, AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL of the said Town of North Bay, as follows:

1. That Paragraphs One (1) and Two (2) of said By-law No. 584 be amended, by including in the list of classes affected by said By-law No. 584, that of "Shoe Repairing Shops."
2. That this By-law take effect from and after the final passing thereof.
