## By-Law No. 2025-43

## Being a By-Law to Set 2025 Tax Ratios for Prescribed Property Classes

**Whereas** The Corporation of the City of North Bay is required to establish tax ratios pursuant to Section 308 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25 as amended (herein referred to as the "Act");

**And Whereas** the tax ratios set out below establish the relative amount of taxation to be borne by each property class;

**And Whereas** the property classes have been prescribed by the Minister of Finance under the *Assessment Act,* R.S.O. 1990, c. A.31, as amended and Regulations thereto;

**And Whereas** Council authorized the by-law to set 2025 tax ratios for the year 2025 by Resolution No. 2025-158 passed by Council at its Regular Meeting on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of April, 2025;

## Now Therefore, the Council of The Corporation of the City of North Bay hereby enacts as follows:

1. Tax Ratios

For the taxation year 2025, the tax ratio for property in the City of North Bay is:

- a) the residential/farm property class is 1.0000;
- b) the multi-residential property class is 1.9900;
- c) the multi-residential new construction property class is 1.0000;
- d) the commercial property class is 1.8800;
- e) the industrial property class is 1.4000;
- f) the aggregate extraction property class 1.139189
- g) the pipelines property class is 1.1656;
- h) the farmlands property class is 0.1500;
- i) the managed forest property class is 0.2500.
- 2. This By-Law shall come into force and take effect upon being passed.
