

BY-LAW NO. 1787

BEING A BY LAW to authorize the construction of a Railway Siding across Judge Avenue.

WHEREAS, the North Bay Salvage and Wrecking Company desire to have a railway siding constructed, maintained and operated by The Canadian National Railway Company across Judge Avenue.


THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT the Corporation of the City of North Bay hereby consents to the construction, maintenance and operation by The Canadian National Railway Company of the aforesaid siding on Judge Avenue aforesaid.
- 2. THAT the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay shall reserve the right to order said siding closed up or removed upon six (6) months written notice served to the Canadian National Railway Company.
- 3. THAT this By-Law shall come into use on the said day of the final passing thereof.
