

BY-LAW NO. 1289

BEING A BY-LAW to regulate the Form and Proof of Applications under Section 82 of The Factory, Shop and Office Building Act.

WHEREAS under The Factory, Shop and Office Building Act it is provided that an application may be made to Council to pass a By-Law requiring the closing of any class or classes of shops for certain periods which present a petition in accordance with the requirements of the said Act.

AND WHEREAS it is further provided in the said Act that Council may by By-Law make regulations as to the form of the application and as to the evidence to be produced respecting the proportion of persons signing the said application and as to the classification of shops for the purposes of Section 82 of the said Act.

AND WHEREAS it has been requested that this Council pass a By-Law classifying said shops under the said section.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY AS FOLLOWS:

1. THE classification of shops for the purpose of Section 82 of The Factory, Shop and Office Building Act, R.S.O. 1937, Chapter 194, be as follows:-
