

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 19-68

BEING A BY-LAW TO ESTABLISH "THE  
NORTH BAY PLANNING BOARD" AND TO  
APPOINT THE MEMBERS THEREOF.

WHEREAS by Order of The Ontario Municipal Board dated the  
23rd day of November, 1967, The Township of Widdifield and The Township  
of West Ferris were annexed to The Corporation of the City of North Bay  
effective the 1st day of January, 1968;

AND WHEREAS, by Paragraph 7 of the aforesaid Annexation Order,  
the Board did order that the Planning Boards of the three municipalities  
aforesaid be dissolved and that there be established for the enlarged City,  
pursuant to the provisions of The Planning Act, a Planning Board  
to consist of eight (8) members;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF  
NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT a Planning Board for the Corporation of the City of North  
Bay be known as The North Bay Planning Board, consisting of eight (8)  
members, be and the same is hereby established.
2. (a) THAT the following persons be appointed members of The North  
Bay Planning Board to hold office until the 1st day of January,  
1969.
  - (1) T.M.H. Bywater
  - (2) A. Kleimaker
- (b) THAT the following persons be appointed members of the North  
Bay Planning Board to hold office until the 1st day of January,  
1970.
  - (1) R. McEwen
  - (2) D. Rooney
  - (3) T. D. Saunders

(c) THAT the following persons be appointed members of the North Bay Planning Board to hold office until the 1st day of January, 1971.




3. THIS BY-LAW shall be retroactive to the 1st day of January, 1968, and shall come into full force and effect upon the final passing thereof and upon receiving the approval of the Minister of Municipal Affairs.
