

BY-LAW NO. 2039

A BY-LAW OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY to establish a policy respecting residency of Municipal Employees.

WHEREAS by Clause No. 2 (as amended) of the General Government Committee Report adopted by City Council on April 16th 1962, a policy respecting residency of Municipal Employees was established, and

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to establish said policy by by-law.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That all Municipal Employees, while employed directly by the City of North Bay and not by a local Board, Commission or other hiring authority, shall reside within the limits of the municipal boundaries of the City of North Bay, excepting only those employees who prior to the passing of this by-law resided outside said municipal boundaries.
2. That this by-law shall become effective on the date of the final passing thereof.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 4TH DAY OF JUNE 1962.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 16TH DAY OF JULY 1962.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 17TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1962.
