

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 2260

Being a By-law prohibiting the sale by retail of any meat in the highways or on vacant lots adjacent to them.

WHEREAS The Municipal Act R.S.O. 1960 Chapter 249 Section 382(2) (subject to Section 383 of The Municipal Act) authorizes the Council of an urban municipality to pass a By-law for prohibiting the sale by retail of any meat in the highways or on vacant lots adjacent to them;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of North Bay, pursuant to the recommendations of the Medical Officer of Health, the Meat Inspector and the North Bay Area Health Unit Board, deems it advisable to enact the within By-law:

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1.(a) The provisions of this By-law shall be applicable to and have full force and effect within the territorial limits of The Corporation of the City of North Bay.

(b) This By-law shall be subject to the provisions of Section 383 of The Municipal Act aforesaid.

2. For the purposes of this By-law:

(a) "Highway" means a common and public highway, and includes a street and a bridge forming part of a highway or on, over or across which a highway passes.

(b) "Meat" shall include all types and kinds of fresh meat, fresh poultry, meat products, poultry products or processed meat.

(c) "Person" shall include firm, partnership, company, corporation or organization.

(d) "Poultry" shall include chickens, ducks, geese, turkeys and birds of any kind.

(e) "Processed Meat" shall include meat or poultry or any combination thereof which has been cooked, salted, smoked, pickled or treated in any way.

(f) "Sale by retail" shall include sale by retail using any type of vehicle or conveyance.

3. No person shall sell by retail any meat in a highway or on a vacant lot adjacent thereto.


4. Any person convicted of a breach of any of the provisions of this By-law shall forfeit and pay, at the discretion of the convicting Magistrate, a fine or penalty not exceeding the sum of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) for each offence, exclusive of costs, to be recoverable under The Summary Convictions Act.


5. All sections of previous By-laws of The Corporation of the City of North Bay relating to the sale by retail of any meat in

a highway or on a vacant lot adjacent thereto shall be deemed to be and they are hereby repealed.


