BY-LAW NO. 1854:

BEING A BY-LAW to prohibit the dumping or placing of snow from private property on City Streets.

WHEREAS the dumping or placing of snow from private property on streets of the Corporation of the City of North Bay constitutes a traffic hazard and public nuisance.

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the said City of North Bay is desirous of preventing such hazard and nuisance.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. No person or Corporation shall dump or place or cause to be dumped or placed any snow or ice from private property on any street of the Corporation of the City of North Bay unless or until such person or Corporation has made previous arrangements with the City and deposited the necessary moneys as required to pay for the removal of such snow or ice by the City.
2. Any person or Corporation convicted of a breach of any of the provisions of this By-law shall forfeit any pay at the discretion of the convicting Magistrate, and a penalty not exceeding the sum of FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00) for each offence, exclusive of the costs, and in default of payment of the said penalty and costs forthwith the said penalty and costs, or costs only, may be levied by distress and sale of the goods and chattels of the offender; and in case of there being no distress found out of which such penalty can be levied, the convicting Magistrate may commit the offender to the Common Gaol of the City of North Bay with or without hard labour for any period not exceeding ten days, unless the said penalty and costs are sooner paid.
3. This By-law shall take effect from the after the passing thereof.
