BY-LAW NUMBER 631.

BEING A BYELAW AMENDING BY-LAW #318, BY ADDING A CLAUSE THERETO, GRANTING THE RIGHT OF APPEAL TO THE TOWN COUNCIL FROM THE DECISION OF THE BUILDING INSPECTOR.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to grant the right of appeal from decisions of the Building Inspector,

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Town of North Bay, enacts as follows, viz.,-

1. That the following clause be added to By-law #318:-

"All applicants to the Building Inspector for
'Permits are to have the right of appeal to
'the Town Council from the decisions of the
'Building Inspector."
