BEING a By-Law to amend By-Law No. 1464, a By-Law regulating Traffic on the Public Highways of the City of North Bay in the District of Nipissing.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable by the Municipal Council of the City of North Bay to amend said By-Law 1464.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. SECTION 12, is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefore;

Parking Restrictions on Specified Streets

When properly worded signs have been erected and are on display, no person shall park a vehicle on any of the streets or parts of streets hereinafter set out in Column 1 on the side or sides of the streets set out in Column 2 during the period set out in Column 3;-

O. No Vehicle shall be parked on any street all night.

P. NO Person shall park a vehicle for a period of longer than one hour on any street between the hours of 12 P.M. and 7 A.M. during the period of November 1st to March 31st, except Physicians on emergency calls.

2. SECTION 29, is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefore;

NO horse or horses shall be left unattended unless securely tethered by means of weights or otherwise and in such a manner as will not impede traffic of any nature.

3. SECTION 32, Subsection B is hereby repealed.

4. THAT SECTION 37, be amended by adding the word "in" after the word "only" in the second line of said clause.
