

A BY-LAW to authorize the construction of certain sidewalks on certain streets in the City of North Bay as a Local improvement under the provisions of The Local Improvement Act.

WHEREAS certain ratepayers, as set out in Schedule "A" hereto attached, and which forms part of this By-law, and others have petitioned the Council to construct as local improvements, the works hereinafter set out in Schedule "A", and the Clerk has certified that the petitions are sufficient, and it is expedient to grant the prayers of the said petitioners in the manner hereinafter provided.

WHEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

- (1) That certain sidewalks be constructed in the City of North Bay as set out in Schedule "A" hereto attached, and which forms part of this By-law, as a local improvement under the provisions of The Local Improvement Act".
- (2) That the Engineer of the Corporation do forthwith make such plans, profiles and specifications and furnish such information as may be necessary for the making of a contract for the execution of the work.
- (3) The work shall be carried on and executed under the superintendence and according to the directions and orders of such Engineer.
- (4) The Mayor and Clerk are authorized to cause a contract for the construction of the work to be made and entered into with some person or persons, firm or corporation, subject to the approval of this Council to be declared by resolution.
- (5) The Treasurer may (subject to the approval of the Council) agree with any bank or person for temporary advances of money to meet the cost of the work pending the completion of it.
- (6) The Special assessment shall be paid by ten (10) annual instalments.
- (7) That the debentures to be issued for the loan to pay for the cost of such work when completed shall bear interest at such rate as the Council may determine and be made payable within ten (10) years on the instalment plan.
- (8) Any person whose lot is specially assessed may commute for a payment in cash the special rates imposed thereon, by paying the portion of the cost of the construction assessed upon such lot, without the interest, forthwith after the special assessment roll has been certified by the Clerk, and at any time thereafter by the payment of such sum as when invested at five per cent, per annum will provide an annuity sufficient to pay the special rates for the unexpired portion of the term as they fall due.

Read a first, second and third time and finally PASSED this 21st day of February, A. D. 1927.
