

**THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY**

**BY-LAW NO. 2001-103**

**BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND TRAFFIC BY-LAW  
NO. 131-93 – SECTION 7– NO PARKING AREAS  
(UTILITY STATIONS)**

**WHEREAS** the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter **M-45**, as amended, authorizes the Council to pass by-laws regulating or prohibiting certain traffic on highways and regulating or prohibiting parking on highways;

**AND WHEREAS** the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter H-8, as amended, authorizes the Council to pass by-laws regulating traffic on highways;

**AND WHEREAS** it is deemed expedient to regulate or prohibit certain traffic and to regulate or prohibit certain parking within the limits of the City of North Bay;

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That Section 7 – No Parking Areas of Traffic By-law No. 131-93 be amended by adding the following:


“Utility stations” - in front of the entrance to any public utility station where authorized signs prohibiting parking are on display.”
