BY-LAW NO. 2006-67

**BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 2005-121  
(BEING THE BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE  
FUNDING OF THE NEW WATER FILTRATION PLANT)**

**WHEREAS** the Council passed Resolution 2005-373 at its meeting held May 24, 2005, authorizing the expenditure of funds for the construction of the new Water Filtration Plant, with a net debenture cost of \$9,000,000.00;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council passed Resolution 2006-149 at its meeting held March 13, 2006, authorizing the amendment to By-law No. 2005-121;

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. Section 1 of By-law No. 2005-121 is hereby deleted and the following inserted in lieu thereof:

"That the expenditure of \$9,000,000.00 for the construction of the new Water Filtration Plant for the following be hereby authorized:

Preliminary water treatability study, pilot testing etc.	\$ 338,000
Detailed design, tender preparation/evaluation	\$ 1,000,000
Building construction value	\$28,350,000
Purchase of membranes	\$ 6,700,000
Land acquisition	\$ 0
Construction services (Consultant's cost of 2.5%)	\$ 1,448,000
Project management (City's and OCWA costs)	\$ 628,000
Building permit and approvals	\$ 241,000
Park reconstruction	\$ 250,000
Landscaping, parking, storm water and site reconstruction	\$ 470,000
Demolition of old building	\$ 200,000
Contingencies (10%)	\$ 4,325,000
Temporary financing costs (3.25%)	<u>\$ 1,550,000</u>


