THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY BY-LAW NO. 112-92

WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to regulate the noise from engines designed for the purpose of the refrigeration of perishable goods.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Schedule 1 of Noise Control By-Law No. 142-76 is hereby amended to delete Paragraph 5(IV) thereof and to insert the following:
 - "5. (IV) Weather conditions justify the use of heating or refrigeration systems powered by the motor or engine for the safety and welfare of the operator, passengers or animals or the preservation of perishable cargo, and the vehicle is stationary for the purposes of delivery or loading only;

2. This By-Law comes into effect upon being passed and upon the approval of the Minister of the Environment pursuant to the Environmental Protection Act.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 25TH DAY OF MAY, 1992.
