BY-LAW NO. 2023-71

**Being a By-Law to Stop Up, Close and Convey
a Part of Ross Drive Road Allowance
Designated as Part 1, on Plan 36R-15016,
in the City of North Bay**

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and in the interest of The Corporation of the City of North Bay that part of the Ross Drive road allowance, designated as Part 1 on Plan 36R-15016, in the City of North Bay be closed, stopped up and sold to the abutting owners;

AND WHEREAS by Resolution No. 2022-243 passed on the 12th day of July, 2022, Council approved the closure of the unopened municipal road allowance (Ross Drive) designated as Part 1 on Plan 36R-15016, in the City of North Bay;

And Whereas notice of this by-law was published pursuant to City of North Bay Notice By-Law 2020-79 on the City of North Bay's Website for two consecutive weeks commencing on August 3, 2023;

AND WHEREAS no person has claimed that his lands will be prejudicially affected by the passing of this by-law nor applied to be heard in person or by his counsel, solicitor, or agent, the Council of the City nor a Committee of said Council;

Now, Therefore, The Council of The Corporation of The City Of North Bay Hereby Enacts as Follows:

1. That certain that part of the Ross Drive road allowance, designated as Part 1 on Plan 36R-15016, in the City of North Bay hereby closed and stopped up.
2. The City shall transfer Part 1, Plan 36R-15016 to the owners of the lands abutting thereon, their successors or assigns, upon receipt of the consent in writing of the abutting registered owner, if the transfer is to be to a person other than the abutting registered owner.
3. This by-law comes into force and effect upon a certified copy of the by-law being registered in the Land Titles Office for the District of Nipissing.
