THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 23-82

BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE PAYMENT OF TAXES AND OTHER ACCOUNTS AT CERTAIN FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS

WHEREAS section 386 (a) of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, chapter 302 provides that Council may pass a by-law to authorize payment of taxes, rates or other accounts at designated chartered banks of Canada, trust companies and credit unions;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Monies payable to The Corporation of the City of North
 Bay for taxes or rates, water accounts, sewer accounts,

 local improvement charges, business taxes or special
 charges for the Downtown Improvement Area shall be paid
 by the tax collector or by the person charged with the
 payment thereof into the following financial institutions:
 - (a) Royal Bank of Canada
 - (b) Canadian Imperial Bank of Commerce
 - (c) Bank of Montreal
 - (d) Bank of Nova Scotia
 - (e) Toronto-Dominion Bank
 - (f) Canada Trust Company
 - (g) Guaranty Trust Company of Canada
 - (h) Victoria and Grey Trust Company
 - (i) Caisse Populaire North Bay Ltee.
 - (j) Northern Ontario Military Credit Union Ltd.
- 2. Any payment directed by section 1 of this by-law shall be to the credit of the Treasurer of The Corporation of the City of North Bay and in such cases the person making the payment shall obtain a receipt for such payment, and the Treasurer or Collector of taxes of the City of North Bay shall make the proper entries therefor in the books of The Corporation of the City of North Bay.
- 3. By-law No. 27-72 is hereby repealed.
