

BY-LAW NUMBER 930.

BEING A BY-LAW to authorize the construction of Sanitary Sewers on certain streets in the City of North Bay as local improvements under the Local Improvement Act, R. S. O. 1927, Chapter 235, Section 9.

UNDER AND BY VIRTUE OF the authority contained in Section 9 of the Local Improvement Act and a Mandatory Order issued as therein provided under the seal of the Department of Health of the Province of Ontario, dated the 16th day of August, A. D. 1929, and approval thereof dated the 16th day of August, A. D. 1929.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. THAT Sanitary Sewers be constructed on certain streets in the City of North Bay as set out in Schedule "A" hereto attached and which forms a part of this By-law as local improvements under the Provisions of the Local Improvement Act together with all necessary private drain connections to the line of the street communicating such sewers.
2. THAT the Engineer of the Corporation do forthwith make such plans, profiles and specifications and furnish such information as may be necessary for the making of a contract for the execution of the work.
3. THAT the work shall be carried on and executed under the superintendence and according to the directions and orders of such Engineer.
4. THE Mayor and Clerk are authorized to cause a Contract for the construction of the work to be made and entered into with some person or persons, firm or corporation, subject to the approval of this Council, to be declared by resolution.
5. THE Treasurer may, subject to the approval of this Council, agree with any Bank or person for temporary advances of money to meet the cost of the work pending the completion of it.
6. THE Special Assessment shall be paid in twenty annual installments.
7. THE Debentures to be issued for the loan to be effected to pay for the cost of the work when completed shall bear interest at 5% per annum and be made payable within twenty years on the instalment plan.
8. ANY person whose lot is specially assessed may commute for a payment in cash the special rate imposed thereon by paying a portion of the cost assessed upon such lot without interest forthwith after the special assessment roll has been certified by the Clerk, and at any time thereafter by payment of such amount as when invested at 5% per annum, will provide an annuity sufficient to pay the special rates for the unexpired portion of the term as they fall due.

Read a first time in Open Council this 3rd day of September 1929.

Read a Second and Third time and passed in Open Council this 3rd day of Sept. A. D. 1929 after Rules of Order were suspended.
